



**SALEM RESIDENT** (\* Proof of Residency Required)

\*SALEM RESIDENTS with a financial hardship will be given the opportunity to apply for a reduced rate structure.

**NON-RESIDENT**

Season Pass	\$20.00 per person \$50.00 per family/household (3-6)
Day Pass	\$4.00 per person \$10.00 per family/household (3-6)
Saturday or Sunday Pass	\$6.00 per person \$15.00 per family/household (3-6)

**GROUP DAY PASSES** -A minimum of 10 people requires you to complete a Facility Request Form. A Permit Fee may be charged. Group rates listed below are charged to cover staffing and/or maintenance, depending upon the nature of the event.

Salem Groups	\$1.00 per person
Out of Town Groups	\$2.00 per person

**Salem resident = Salem residence (not business), immediate family only!**

**WHERE TO PURCHASE PASSES**

Passes may be purchased at the Town Hall's Recreation Department at the end of May 2002 during the office hours of 8:30am to 5:00pm. Our telephone number is (603) 890-2140.

Proof of residency is required to purchase Resident passes.

Day passes for Salem residents, with Proof of Residency, may be purchased at Hedgehog Park during the open season.

The TOWN OF SALEM, NEW HAMPSHIRE, RECREATION DEPARTMENT, would like to inform all users of the Park and beach of the following Rules and Regulations:

- 1) It is in the Town Ordinance (revised April 1992-Section 235-11, letter E) stating “NO person shall feed any wild animals in the Park; including water animals such as geese, ducks, etc., in the body of water in any park”. Therefore, we ask that no one feed the ducks! **PLEASE DO NOT FEED THE DUCKS.**
- 2) **NO liquor** of any kind is allowed within any Town Park, including no wine coolers nor beer. (Section 235-13 - A)
- 3) **NO glass containers** (such as soft drink bottles or baby food jars, etc.) shall be taken into or used in any part of any Park, including ball fields and beaches. Only paper or plastic containers are allowed. (Section 235-17)
- 4) **GENERAL SWIMMING RULES:** Inflatables, all types of floatation equipment, life jackets, swim fins, face masks, goggles and snorkel tubes shall **not** be permitted in the water.
  - A. Non-swimmers and poor swimmers may depend upon floatation devices instead of their swimming abilities to take them to and from deep water. It gives them a false sense of security. If the device breaks down (deflates, etc.) or gets away, the individual may find him/her self in trouble. (Some floatation devices may have all the safeguards and approvals necessary, but we cannot get into the business of inspection and certification of equipment.)
  - B. Fins also give a false sense of swimming ability and cause poor swimmers to venture too far. They can also cause cramps which can disable a swimmer.
  - C. Masks and snorkels can be hazardous to even good swimmers in that they may cause the user to choke and panic. This also encourages more underwater activity which increases the difficulty of life guard supervision.
- 5) **LOST PASSES:** Beach passes lost by Salem residents and non-residents will be replaced for a \$5.00 fee.
- 6) **WEATHER:** On bad weather days, the park may be closed. When the park is open and the weather becomes inclement, the park will close and everyone at the park will need to leave the premises.
- 7) When the park closes for the evening, everyone must leave the park.

**PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT THE MAXIMUM PENALTY FOR VIOLATING THIS ORDINANCE SHALL NOT EXCEED ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000).**
